# Readings for the Blessed Virgin Mary (the Eleventh Sunday after Trinity)

#### Isaiah 61.10-end

I will greatly rejoice in the LORD,
my whole being shall exult in my God;
for he has clothed me with the garments of salvation,
he has covered me with the robe of righteousness,
as a bridegroom decks himself with a garland,
and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.
For as the earth brings forth its shoots,
and as a garden causes what is sown in it to spring up,
so the Lord God will cause righteousness and praise
to spring up before all the nations.

#### **Psalm 45. 10-end**

Hear, O daughter, consider and incline your ear; forget your people and your father's house, and the king will desire your beauty.

Since he is your lord, bow to him;

the people of Tyre will seek your favour with gifts, the richest of the people with all kinds of wealth.

The princess is decked in her chamber with gold-woven robes; in many-coloured robes she is led to the king; behind her the virgins, her companions, follow.

With joy and gladness they are led along as they enter the palace of the king.

In the place of ancestors you, O king, shall have sons; you will make them princes in all the earth.

I will cause your name to be celebrated in all generations; therefore the peoples will praise you for ever and ever.
