Lent Reflections via Zoom

This year our Lenten Reflections are taking place via zoom on Wednesday evenings at 7.00pm—see the joining details above—and our theme is 'Lenten Landscapes'. These times of reflection are stand alone and open to all so please do join us if you are able—it doesn't matter if you have missed one. Zoom is not that difficult to use, but if you would like a trial run do get in touch with either Revd. John or Revd. Carole and we will be happy to walk you through the process.

Following the government's announcement of its roadmap for moving out of lockdown, we are now in a position to plan a gradual return to holding church services in the buildings once again. This will start on Sunday 14th March, when we shall hold a short Mothering Sunday service in Kingsbury Church at 11am. The following Sunday, there will be services at 11am at Merevale and 4.30pm at Baxterley. Wednesday morning services at Wood End will start again at 9.30am each week from 24th March.

Those attending services in church are asked to take particular care to minimise the risk of virus transmission. Please wear face coverings, use the hand sanitiser, and avoid social interaction. Online services will continue, so please stay at home if you feel you are at risk or are self-isolating.
